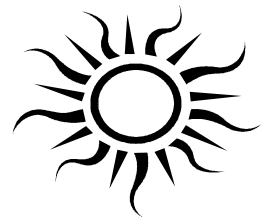

How do I register?

When mailing, please use the address above. All registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. **Full payment is required with registration. Refunds granted, less a \$5 administration fee up to five business days prior to the event or program beginning.** Sorry, no refunds for special events or trips. **Notification will occur only if a program is full or if program changes are necessary.** Please follow registration deadlines where stated. Programs without specific registration information will have a deadline of 5 business days prior to the start date. Please call with any questions.

SCHOOL DISTRICT ANIMAL POLICY (Policy 384)



Animals on School Grounds

Animals are not allowed on school grounds during school hours and public activities. Citizens walking their dogs or other animals through school property must maintain control of the leashed animal and clean up any droppings left by such animal on the District property and are also subject to local laws and ordinance pertaining to animal control.

The only exceptions to this will be for curriculum related activities or other instances as approved by the building principal and for licensed service dogs for individuals with an appropriate disability.
