Village of West Salem, Wisconsin: The Village has recently received a significant number of resident complaints about wandering domestic, stray, and feral cats. The Village is asking for compliance from cat owners who may be letting their cats wander outside unleashed. Ordinance No. 11.08(D) addresses animals running at large. An animal off of the owner's premises and not under control of its owner is considered "running at large". The penalty to the owner for violating this Section is not less than \$25 nor more than \$250, and each day of the violation is a separate offense. If a cat is trapped by law enforcement or residents and transported to the Coulee Region Humane Society, additional fees will be charged to the cat owner.
